Record minutes and activities every week to be entered into a weekly prize drawing! If you complete your reading goal by Friday, August 1 at 5:00pm, you will be entered into our Grand Prize Drawing.

Register for the reading program online at cherryvalleylib.beanstack.org, or by using the Beanstack app, beginning Tuesday, May 27. The Beanstack app can be downloaded onto a phone or tablet and makes recording your minutes and activities easy! The app includes a reading timer, ISBN scanner for title entry, and the capability to record minutes for multiple readers simulaneously. The last day to register for the reading challenge will be Saturday, July 5.

If you participated in last year's program, you will use the same Beanstack username and password. Can't remember your password or have other questions? Call the library at 815.332.5161 and library staff will be happy to assist you!
